MISSION

Disc Golf For All exists to remove barriers and create opportunities for people of all abilities and circumstances to experience the physical, social, educational, and community benefits of disc golf through equipment, instruction, mentorship, and inclusive programming provided without cost to participants.

Who We Are

Disc Golf For All (DGFA) is a Mississippi nonprofit organization based in Gulfport and created to expand access to disc golf by removing the barriers that keep people from participating. DGFA provides equipment, instruction, encouragement, and continuing opportunities so that cost, ability, background, prior experience, or circumstance do not determine who gets to belong.

DGFA uses disc golf as a practical vehicle for healthy movement, confidence, mentorship, friendship, learning, dignity, and community connection. Programs are designed to meet people where they are and to create a pathway from a first experience to continued participation.

Who We Intend to Serve

Youth & Schools	No-cost introductions, equipment, learning experiences, mentorship, and recurring opportunities.
People with Disabilities	Inclusive and adaptive participation built around individual ability, dignity, access, and choice.
Veterans, Service Members & Military Families	Community connection, recreation, peer engagement, and future adaptive programming.
Returning Citizens	Positive recreation, belonging, mentorship, routine, and constructive community connection.
Underserved Community Members	Access for people whose financial or social circumstances might otherwise prevent participation.

Disc golf is the medium, not the message.

The discs, baskets, and courses are the tools. The intended outcomes are human: belonging, confidence, healthy activity, supportive relationships, personal growth, and opportunities to contribute to the community.

HOW DGFA SERVES

A pathway from first throw to continued belonging.

Core Program Structure

FIRST FLIGHT KIT	Provides participants with quality, age- and ability-appropriate equipment needed to begin and continue playing without a financial barrier.
FIRST FLIGHT GUIDES	Connects participants with people who provide instruction, encouragement, mentorship, and a welcoming introduction to the sport and its community.
DGFA PATHWAYS	Creates continued opportunities beyond the first experience through recurring programming, mentorship, community involvement, and opportunities to serve others.

Accountability & Measurement

DGFA is designed to pair compassionate service with disciplined stewardship. Program records will be used to understand reach, participation, continued engagement, and whether the organization is creating meaningful opportunities for the people it serves.
